Red Wine

Julio Bouchon Cabernet Sauvignon - Chile, Maule Valley
Big, rich and concentrated with ripe blackberry fruits.

Alkoomi Shiraz - Australia, Frankln River
Floral and earthy fragrance of dark plums, cassis and dark chocolate overlies vanilla oak and a touch of exotic muskiness.

Crasto - Portugal, Douro DDC
Black cherries and ripe strawberries on the nose lead to a rich and well balanced palate with ripe black fruits and a smooth, long finish.

Domaine des Terres Dorees - France Beaujolais AC
Incredible raspberry fruits on the nose that follow through on the palate. Beaujolais as it should be.

Domaine de Terre Megere Merlot - France, Coteaux du Languedoc AC
Plum like fruit overlain with hints of spice in a smooth finish.

Rondan Crianza - Spain, Rioja DDC
A very expressive and complex bouquet leads to ripe fruit spiciness with a silky feel in the mouth. Good body, balance and roundness.

Sticks Shiraz, Viognier - Australia, Yarra Valley
Wonderfully tasty ripe, pure fruit with lots of dark fruit flavours and a big flavoursome finish, a crowd pleaser.

Stefano Accordini Valpolicella - Italy, Valpolicella DDC
A vibrant youthful nose displaying pure aromas of cherry, red plum, violets and aromatic herbs. A dry, medium bodied palate with succulent red fruit flavours.

Sticks Pinot Noir - Australia, Yarra Valley
Cherry, strawberry and spice aromas with balanced supporting oak on the finish.

White Wine

Julio Bouchon Sauvignon Blanc - Chile, Maule Valley
An elegant wine, fresh on the palate with good acidity, citrus fruits and some mineral notes with a touch of herbs.

Blanco Nieva Verdejo - Spain, Rueda DO
Shows notes of minerals, and Granny Smith apples. Lush with lively, fruit driven flavours of lemon, smoke and nutty hints. Finishes very long.

l'Hortus Rose - France, Coteaux du Languedoc AC
Attractive pink colour. Ripe, red summer fruits with a crisp finish.

Sticks Chardonnay, Viognier - Australia, Yarra Valley
Very pure ripe fruits with abundant citrus with a subtle orange edge and good, crisp acidity.

Alkoomi Unwooded Chardonnay - Australia, Frankln River
Vibrant and attractive aromas of peach and guava. The palate is clean with undertones of grapefruit and tropical stone fruit flavours.

Bidoli Pinot Grigio - Italy, Grave del Friuli DDC
Pear and apple aromas dominate the nose which echoes the lively tangy freshness of the well balanced palate. Refreshing acidity and good length.

Steininger Grüner Veltliner - Austria, Kamptal Valley
Light, floral summer white fruits nose leading to crisp acidity a mineral finish.

Domaine Mader Riesling - France, Alsace AC
Clean and ripe citrus fruit is balanced by crisp acidity. Medium bodied and very long. A classic single - vineyard Alsace Riesling.

Paddy Borthwick Sauvignon Blanc - New Zealand, Wairarapa
Aromas of gooseberry, guava and pineapple supported by intense flavours of tropical fruit resulting in a wine with great balance, structure and finesse.
